Good news for IRA owners age 70½ or over

If you are age 70 ½ or over, a qualified charitable distribution (or IRA rollover) is a great way to minimize the tax bite associated with IRA required minimum distributions.

- Instruct your IRA custodian to make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) by a direct transfer to Columbia University Irving Medical Center.
- Although there is no tax deduction, the QCD counts toward your required minimum distribution and is excluded from your income for federal tax purposes—no tax is due!
- Up to \$100,000 of your gift qualifies for this favorable tax treatment.
- Your gift makes an immediate impact—there is no need to wait until the end of the year!
